



2018 Gladstone Prize Shortlist

The Royal Historical Society offers an annual award of £1,000 for a history book published in English on any topic that is not primarily British history. To be eligible for the prize the book must be its author's first solely written book on a historical subject which is not primarily related to British history. The book must have been published in English in 2017 and be an original and scholarly work of historical research by an author who received their doctoral degree from a British or Irish university. This award is supported by a generous grant from the Linbury Trust.
